We Believe: in Jesus (Various Texts)

EFCA Statement of Faith, Article 4

We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus—Israel's promised Messiah—was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.

God Incarnate

- Jesus is God who took on humanity (John 1:14, 18; 1 John 4:2)
 - oHe is fully God (John 1:1; Col 2:9; John 20:28; Rom 9:5)
 - oHe is fully <u>human</u> (1 John 1:1-3; Heb 5:7-8)
 - And experienced all that being human entails (Luke 2:40, 52; Matt 4:2; John 11:35)

Messiah

- Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promise of an <u>eternal king</u> (2 Sam 7:12-13; Gen. 3:14-20; 12:1-3; 49:8-12; Matt. 1:1, 17; Lk. 4:16-22; 24:25-27; Jn. 1:41; 4:25-26; Acts 2:36; 13:23,32; Rom 1:2-3; 2 Tim. 2:8,9)
 - oWhich is possible because He was conceived by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> & born of the <u>virgin Mary</u> (Luke 1:34-35; Matt 1:18)

High Priest & Advocate

- Because He is fully human, Jesus faced <u>temptation</u> like we do, but never <u>sinned</u> (Heb. 4:15; Rom. 5:19; Gal. 4:4,5; Matt. 3:15; Phil. 2:7,8)
 - o And though He was <u>innocent</u>, He still died the death of the <u>guilty</u> (Mark 15:15; Dt. 21:23; Ps. 16:10; Matt. 27:26; Lk. 23:16; Jn. 19:16; Acts 2:27, 37)
- But because Jesus is fully God, death could not hold Him
 - oHe was raised <u>bodily</u> from the dead (Luke 24:39; Matt. 28:1-10; Mk. 16:1-8; Rom. 4:25; 1 Cor. 15:20, 44-45; Col. 1:18; Rev. 1:5)
 - o And then returned to heaven (Luke 24:51; Acts 1:6-11; Eph. 1:20; 4:8-10; 1 Tim. 3:16)
 - oAnd reclaimed His rightful place at the <u>right hand</u> of the <u>Father</u> (Heb 1:3; Eph. 1:20; Col. 3:1; 8:1; 10:12; 1 Pet. 3:22)
- All of this makes Jesus the perfect <u>High Priest</u> & <u>Advocate</u> for humanity oHigh Priest: One who <u>represents</u> people before God (Heb. 2:17; Heb. 3:1; 4:14; 6:20; 8:1) oAdvocate: One who pleads one case before a <u>judge</u> (1 Jn. 2:1; Rom. 8: 34; Heb. 7:25; 9:24)

So What?
