The Claim: "God wants me to be rich."

• Underlying premise: My <u>comfort</u> is of utmost importance.

Scripture's Truth

- Wealth/money is talked about a lot in Scripture

 Sometimes good (Ecc. 5:19)
 Sometimes bad (Matt. 6:24)
- So, how do we understand wealth's role in life? • By looking at the whole <u>counsel</u> of Scripture
- Scripture makes it clear that true wealth comes from the Lord (Deut. 8:17-18)
- What we do with money is of greater importance than how much we have (Luke 21:1-4)
- And we are called to honor God with whatever amount that is (Pro. 3:9)
- We are NOT to trust in our wealth or lack thereof (Ps. 49:5-6; Ecc. 5:10; Luke 18:24-27)

What are We Chasing?

God doesn't want us to chase after <u>wealth</u> (1 Tim 6:10)
 But rather, to chase after <u>Him</u> (Matt. 6:25-33)

Contentment is Key

- God wants us to learn to be <u>content</u> in whatever He gives us (Phil. 4:10-13)
- It's about trusting God for our 'daily bread' (Matt. 6:11; Pro. 30:7-9; Ps. 23:2)

- What are we chasing in life?
- Are we learning to be content with whatever God gives us?
