Ephesians: Final Thoughts

(Ephesians 6:18-24)

Watch & Pray (v. 18-20)

- Paul's final word of instruction in this letter is focused on prayer oIt is essential for the spiritual battles that believers face (v. 10-16)
- The Holy Spirit should lead our prayer life o'That's what it means to pray "in/by the Spirit" oHe directs us in how we pray & what we pray for
- We are called to be <u>alert</u>
 - OAware of our surroundings in a way that leads to selfless prayer
 - For <u>fellow Christians</u> who are undergoing spiritual battles too, even those we do not know o And for those on the <u>front lines</u> of <u>ministry</u> like Paul was
 - That they might declare the Gospel clearly and with boldness

Final Greetings (v. 21-24)

- Paul ends the letter with instructions regarding Tychicus, Paul's trusted <u>courier</u> who was from the region of Asia Minor to which this letter was addressed (Acts 20:4; Col 4:7; 2 Tim 4:12; Tts 3:12)
- He ends the letter with the same words that opened it: <u>Peace</u> & <u>Grace</u> (1:2)

So What?

- Are we prayer warriors?
 oLifting up others in the battles they face
 oAnd those on the front lines of ministry
- We are going to begin looking at Jesus' instruction on prayer in the weeks to come
