# The Gospel of John: On Whose Testimony

John 5:31-47

### Testimony as Evidence (v. 31-35)

- Jesus continues His argument stating the evidence for His authority to heal is based on His identity as the <u>Son</u> of <u>God</u> (v. 25)
- This claim is not based on His own <u>testimony</u>
  No one can simply state something to be <u>true</u> without <u>evidence</u>
- It must be based on the evidence of another who is trustworthy
- He points to <u>John</u> the <u>Baptizer</u>, whom the Jewish leadership has sought out repeatedly (1:19ff; 3:25ff), as a <u>human witness</u> of who Jesus is
  - OBut Jesus claims that because of the <u>magnitude</u> of the claim that He is making, human testimony isn't enough
- A greater witness is needed

### A Weightier Testimony (v. 36-40)

- Jesus' <u>Father</u> provides a greater testimony
  - OJesus' works that act as evidence of His identity & authority as the one sent by the Father
    - This includes the signs He performs
    - And will culminate on the Cross
  - The Scriptures also testify to who Jesus is
- The Jewish leadership doesn't have an <u>intimate relationship</u> with God, so they don't recognize His works on display in Jesus
  - OInstead, they put their hope in their human understanding of the Scriptures
- Studying the Scriptures is not inherently <u>life-giving</u> unless one understands their true purpose oWhich is to point us to <u>Jesus</u>, the <u>Giver</u> of <u>Life</u>.

## Misplaced Hope (v. 41-47)

- The religious leaders want men's praise and do not seek God's pleasure
- Jesus is not looking for <u>human</u> accolades • He desires to please His <u>Father</u>
- They have put their hope of righteousness in their <u>understanding</u> of & <u>obedience</u> to the Law of <u>Moses</u>
  - 0 And fail to realize that Moses was pointing them to Jesus (Dt 18:15)
  - To not trust in Jesus is to disobey what Moses taught
    - The entire Old Testament points to Jesus (1 Pet 1:10-12)

### So What?

- Do we trust God's testimony about who Jesus is?
- Is our hope in Christ alone?
- Are we bearing witness to Jesus with our words & deeds?
