 Some Judean Christians come to Antioch and start preaching that in order to be saved
Gentiles must undergo
o: Those who believe that one must follow Mosaic Law in order to be a true
Christian (see Acts 11:1-3)
 Paul & Barnabus quickly dispute this claim
OBut no agreement can be reached, so they are sent to to ask the Apostles
& elders there which view is correct
 Paul & Barnabus travel through Phoenicia & Samaria on the way
 Reporting about the conversion of the Gentiles with a response of great
When they arrive in, they give the same report
 But some Jewish Christians who belong to the sect of the raise the Judaizing
issue again
OWhat is required for someone to be a saved?
Saved by (v. 6-11)
• The apostles and elders gather to discuss the issue and come to a conclusion
-
OBased off experience of Gentile conversions and receiving the Holy Spirit (Acts 10)
• They see that God makes no between Jew & Gentile
oBoth are saved by through in Jesus
• They correct the Judaizers by pointing to the own struggle with the Mosaic Law (v. 10)
So What?
We are saved by grace through faith in Jesus
 Nothing more and nothing less
• Are we trusting in Him alone?
