All about Fruit

- Fruit is the product of a healthy flowering plant
- Two types of flowering plants don't produce fruit
 - <u>Immature</u>
 - Unhealthy
- The purpose of fruit is to help the plant reproduce
 - ○To make more <u>healthy</u>, <u>reproducing</u> plants

Fruit Trees

- Jesus uses the imagery of fruit trees frequently
 - OWhen speaking of false teachers (Matt. 7:15-20)
 - OWarning of the fruitlessness of Israel (Luke 13:6-9)
 - As did John the Baptist (Luke 3:7-9)
 - OShowing the duplicity of the human heart (Matt. 12:33-35)
- He used it as a metaphor for what real life with Him looks like (John 15:1-8)

The Fruit of the Spirit

- Paul uses the same imagery to describe the results of where we get our <u>identity</u> and <u>power</u> from
 - OWhen we are controlled by our <u>flesh/sinful</u> nature/<u>selves</u>, we produce <u>wicked</u> fruits (Gal. 5:19-21)
 - oBut when we let the <u>Holy Spirit</u> of God control and empower us, He produces something <u>beautiful</u> and <u>life-giving</u> (Gal. 5:22-23)
- This is one fruit
 - Karpas = singular; "the fruit of the Spirit is..."
 - oIt's like a _____
 - ○He produces all of this in all of us if we are connected to Jesus, the source of life

The Danger of Fake Fruit

- We often mistakenly think that we produce this fruit
 - OAnd thus, we try with all our might to act the right way
 - When we succeed, it produces self-righteousness & pride
 - When we fail, it produces shame & guilt
- The danger lies when we settle for fake fruit (Isa. 64:6)

OAnd we demand it of others

- Even those who are not connected to Jesus!
 - It is demanding <u>self-righteous</u> rather than <u>repentance</u> and a <u>living-giving relationship</u> with Jesus
 - It is the very thing that Jesus railed against the Pharisees for
- Real fruit is produced by the Spirit at work in us
- The purpose of fruit is to help the plant reproduce
 - oTo make more <u>healthy</u>, <u>reproducing</u> plants
