We Believe in the Holy Spirit (Various Texts)

EFCA Statement of Faith, Article 6

We believe that the Holy Spirit, in all that He does, glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. He convicts the world of its guilt. He regenerates sinners, and in Him they are baptized into union with Christ and adopted as heirs in the family of God. He also indwells, illuminates, guides, equips and empowers believers for Christ-like living and service.

Who the Spirit Is

- The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity
 Like Jesus, He is fully <u>God</u>
 And as a member of the Trinity, He <u>glorifies</u> the other members (John 16:14)
- The Gospel authors make it clear that the work that <u>Jesus</u> did was through the power of the Holy Spirit (Matt 3:16; Mark 1:10; Luke 3:22; John 1:32)
- And it through the Holy Spirit that followers of Jesus experience the <u>presence</u> and <u>power</u> of God (John 14:16-17)

What the Spirit Does to Us

- He convicts us of our sinfulness & need for Jesus (John 16:8; 1 Cor. 2:14)
- He <u>regenerates</u> us to be more like Jesus (Tts. 3:5; Ezek. 36:25-27; Jn. 3:3, 5; 1 Cor. 12:3; 2 Cor. 5:17; Eph. 2:5; Col. 2:13; 1 Thess. 1:4-5; 2 Thess. 2:13; Jas. 1:18; 1 Pet. 1:3)
- He is enables us to be <u>united</u> with Christ (Eph. 4:4-6; Rom. 3:24; 5:15-21; 12:5; 1 Cor. 1:2; 6:19; 15:22b; 2 Cor. 5:17; Gal. 1:22; 2:17; 3:28; Eph. 1:4; 2:12; 3:6; 4:32; 2 Tim. 2:10; 1 Thess. 4:16) oSymbolized through <u>baptism</u> (Mark 1:8; see Act 1:5; 1 Cor. 12:13)
- This union makes us <u>adopted children</u> of God (Rom 8:15, 23; Matt. 12:49-50; Rom. 9:4; 2 Cor. 6:18; Gal. 4:5; Eph. 1:5; 3:14; Tts. 3:7; 1 Jn. 3:14-18)

What the Spirit Does through Us

- With this new identity, the Spirit:
 - o<u>Indwells</u> us (Rom 8:11; Matt 9:17; John 14:17; 1 Cor 3:16)
 - oEnlightens us (Heb. 10:32; 1 Cor. 2:2; 2 Cor. 4:4-15; Eph. 1:17-19; Phil. 1:9-11)
 - oGuides us (Jn. 16:13; Acts 15:28; Rom. 8:4, 14; Gal. 5:16, 18)
 - oEmpowers us (1 Cor. 12:11; Acts 1:8; 10:38; Rom. 15:13; Eph. 3:16; 2 Tim. 1:7)
- This is all so we can <u>live</u> like <u>Jesus</u> (John 14:12, 16; Acts 6:8; Rom. 8:4-6, 12-16; 2 Cor. 13:14; Gal. 3:3, 5; 5:22-23, 25; Eph. 2:22; 4:3; Phil. 2:1-2).

So What?

- If we have surrendered our lives to Jesus, we have the Holy Spirit dwelling inside us
- Are we living through the Spirit's power?
