We Believe in the Living out Our Faith, part 2 (Various Texts)

EFCA Statement of Faith, Article 8

We believe that God's justifying grace must not be separated from His sanctifying power and purpose. God commands us to love Him supremely and others sacrificially, and to live out our faith with care for one another, compassion toward the poor and justice for the oppressed. With God's Word, the Spirit's power, and fervent prayer in Christ's name, we are to combat the spiritual forces of evil. In obedience to Christ's commission, we are to make disciples among all people, always bearing witness to the gospel in word and deed.

The Church as an Army

- As God's people, the Church is engaged in a war
- oNOT against other people or society
- oBut against evil spiritual forces (Eph. 6:12; 3:10; see 2 Cor. 10:3-5; Eph. 1:21; 1 Jn. 5:3-4)
- Because our battle is spiritual, are weapons need to be as well (Eph. 6:13-18a)
 - oGod's word
 - oThe Spirit's power
 - oFervent prayer

Christ's Commission

- With this arsenal in place, we are called to a mission (Matt. 28:19-20; Matt. 16:16-18)
- To make <u>disciples</u> of Jesus: <u>dedicated</u> followers
 - oFrom among all people
 - OStarting in our backyard & going to the whole world (Acts 1:8)
- We make disciples by:
 - OBaptizing them: Inclusion in relationship with the Trinity
 - oTeaching them obedience: Which involves both active instruction & modeling behavior
 - "In <u>word</u> & <u>deed</u>" (Matt. 5:13-16)
- All done through the power of the Spirit of Christ in us (Matt. 28:20b)
