Ecclesiastes: Seeking Good

Ecclesiastes 5 & 6

Worship (5:1-7)

- We ought to come to God <u>quietly</u> & <u>humbly</u> (v. 1-3) oReady to listen rather than speak
 - A quiet heart is better than sacrifice
- We ought to be quick to fulfill our <u>promises</u>, especially to <u>God</u> (v. 4-6) oIt is better not to make promises than not to <u>keep</u> them
- We need to be careful with our <u>dreaming</u> (v. 7)
 OPlanning for the future must be <u>limited</u>
 Only <u>God</u> knows what the future holds (see Jas 4:13-16)

Corruption (v. 8-9)

- <u>Corruption</u> exists within any political system (v. 8) o And the more people involved, the more corruption is likely
- However, without some <u>oversight</u>, society would break down (v. 9) oEven the <u>farmer</u> benefits from a just <u>king</u>

Sharing & Contentment (5:10-6:9)

- Human appetites drive us and yet are never satisfied (6:7)
 - OWealth & pleasure (5:10-20)
 - o<u>Power & security</u> (6:1-6)
 - ○<u>Wisdom</u> (6:7-9)
 - o<u>Fame</u> (6:10-12)
- Hoarding any of these is a sin
 - OWe are called to share what we have with those in need
 - OAnd to use the position & resources that God has allotted us for something that lasts
- We might amass goods, but they may not lead us to goodness
 - oThis is even true when it comes to things normally seen as <u>biblical blessings</u>, like <u>children</u> & long <u>life</u>
- We are better off being <u>content</u> with what we have than constantly chasing more of any of these things (6:9)

Seeking a Name (v. 10-12)

- Everything has already been <u>named</u> (Gen. 2:20) • Including "Man"/Adam = <u>Dust</u>
- Yet we strive to make a name for <u>ourselves</u> oSee Gen. 6:4, "men of renown" = "men of a name"
- By doing so, we contend with the <u>Creator</u> (v. 10-11; see Gen. 3:5) oWho alone knows what is <u>best</u> and what is to <u>come</u> (v. 12)

So What?

- Are our lives devoted to just ourselves, to accumulating wealth, power, & fame?
- Or are we devoting ourselves to God & others through worship and sharing what God has blessed us with
