ACTS: Praising in Prison

Acts 16:25-40

Praising in Prison (v. 25-27)

- At midnight Paul & Silas beginning singing <u>praise</u> to God even while imprisoned o'This demonstrates true <u>joy</u> in every circumstance (Phil. 4:4)
 - OAs a result, their fellow prisoners are listening to a praise service exalting the excellencies of the one true God, whose word alone can show the way of <u>salvation</u>
- God sends an earthquake which miraculously opens all the <u>cells</u> and loosens the <u>chains</u> oJust like God did for the <u>Apostles</u> (Acts 5:19ff) & <u>Peter</u> (Acts 12:5-19)
- When the jailer realizes what has happened, he supposes that everyone has <u>escaped</u> oHe plans to <u>kill</u> himself rather than face the cruelties of Roman <u>justice</u>

A Jailer Set Free (v. 28-34)

- Paul informs the jailer that they have not tried to escape
- Once the jailer understands the miracle that has occurred and connects it with Paul & Silas, he asks about the <u>salvation</u> that they were singing about
 - oPaul makes clear what is needed: "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." (v. 31)
- After further explanation from Paul, the jailer and his whole household put their <u>faith</u> in <u>Jesus</u> oThey are <u>baptized</u>
 - oHe cleans up Paul & Silas
 - OHe invites them into his home, which was probably connected to the jail
 - And he treats them like honored guests
- The miracle was not meant to set the Apostles free, but rather to set the jailer and his family free

Humbling the Proud (v. 35-40)

- The next day, the city magistrates decide to <u>release</u> the Apostles oProbably preferring to get them out of town than continuing to deal with them
- Paul insists that they come do it themselves • Citing that both he and Silas are <u>Roman citizens</u> and have been wrongly treated
- The magistrates grow fearful because of the Apostle's citizenship & agree to escort them out oIt was akin to a public <u>apology</u>
- They ask them to <u>leave town</u>
 Which they do after visiting with <u>Lydia</u> and the newly formed <u>Church</u>

So What?

- Paul & Silas demonstrated joy in the midst of suffering oDo we do the same?
- God works miracles to draw people to Himself
 ODo we trust Him to still do so?
