Seeing the Forest for the Trees

- What is the big picture of history?
- Scripture gives us the story of God's work from the beginning to the end oMetanarrative
- One way to talk about this is through the repeated theme of covenants
- Covenants involve promises on the part of one or both parties
 - oThroughout salvation history, God has established covenants with individuals or groups that show us His ultimate plan and purpose for humanity

Our First Parents

- Adam & Eve were made in God's image (Gen. 1:26-27)
- They were instructed to do 3 things:
 - OBe fruitful and multiply (1:28)
 - oTend the Garden (2:15)
 - oDo not eat the fruit from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good & Evil (2:15-17)
- Adam & Eve didn't know right and wrong
 - They only knew to obey
 - oThey failed
 - We all pay the price for their <u>disobedience</u>
 - And we all inherit their <u>sinful</u> <u>nature</u>

The Adamic Covenant (Gen. 3:14-19)

- God makes a covenant with Adam, Eve, and the Serpent o Curses are handed out because of their disobedience
- Adam= All of <u>humanity</u>
 - oWill suffer toil
 - oWill suffer death
- Eve= Specifically women
 - OWill suffer pain in childbearing
 - OWill suffer inequality in their relationships with men
 - Eve was made to be a partner/equal(Gen. 2:18, 23)
- The Serpent= <u>Satan/evil</u>
 - OWill suffer humiliation
 - oWill be destroyed

God's Part of the Covenant

- Humans messed things up, but God will make it right
- God will use a <u>human agent</u> to do so
 - oA descendant of Eve
- The Serpent/Satan will be defeated

Humanity's Part of the Covenant

- <u>Populate</u> the Earth
- <u>Care</u> for the Earth
- <u>Obey</u>
