Various texts

What is Joy?

- It is NOT an <u>emotion</u>
 Unlike happiness
- Joy is the choice
 - o Like love
- It is about how we choose to see our circumstances
- Biblical joy is choosing to <u>respond</u> to external circumstances with inner <u>contentment</u> and <u>satisfaction</u>, because we know that God will use these experiences to accomplish His <u>work</u> in and through our lives

Joy in Trials (Rom. 5:3-5)

- Joy can be found in trials and suffering because of our <u>perspective</u> on what God is doing through them
- God uses hardships to help produce endurance (see Jas. 1:2-4, 12)
 - Which produces <u>character</u>
 - Which produces <u>hope</u>
- And all of this is rooted in God's love for us
 - O Evidenced by the Holy Spirit's presence in us

Real Joy

- This joy is not humanly manufactured
 - oIt is from the Lord Himself (Neh. 8:10b)
 - OAnd the reason it part of the fruit of the Spirit
- And this joy, regardless of circumstances, should lead us to <u>praise</u> God

So What?

- Are we letting God change our perspective?
 - OHelping us to be joyful in all circumstances
 - Praising Him in every situation
