The Gospel of John: Born Again

John 3:1-13

Nicodemus (v. 1-2)

- Jesus is approached by Nicodemus
 - oPharisee: One of 3 sects of Jews who accepted and earnestly sought to follow the whole of the Old Testament
 - Jesus has more direct contact with them because of their <u>similarities</u>
 - OMember of the Sanhedrin: The Jewish ruling council that oversaw religious affairs
- His arrival at night reflects:
 - oThe secretive nature of his visit
 - OHis spiritually <u>dark/blind</u> state (v. 9-10)
- He seeks out Jesus believing that He is <u>sent</u> from God based on the evidence of the <u>signs</u> that Jesus has been performing
 - ONicodemus' statement implies a question: "Who are you?"

The Need for Rebirth (v. 3-8)

- Jesus responds to Nicodemus' implied question by asserting that to have the ability to assess any heavenly truth, one must be born ἄνωθεν
 - oἄνωθεν (anothen): <u>Again</u>/from <u>above</u>
 - This is a deliberate play on words
- Nicodemus understands it to mean a second physical birth
- Jesus clarifies that this new birth must be through the work of the Holy Spirit
 - oThe reference to water and Spirit is likely an allusion to Ezek. 36:25-27, which promises God's <u>cleansing</u> work and giving of the <u>Spirit</u> in the <u>Messianic</u> age
- Spirit/wind are the same word in Greek (pneuma)
 - oThose born of the Spirit (as Jesus is) do not act as the world presupposes

The Question Answered (v. 9-13)

- Nicodemus does not <u>understand</u>, so Jesus <u>corrects</u> him
 - oPharisees taught that being obedient to the <u>Law</u> and "the <u>tradition</u> of the elders" (Mk 7:3-5) was what secured one's place in the kingdom of God
 - OBut the true requirement is new birth from above, which Jesus freely offers
- Jesus explains that He knows these things with certainty because of who He is and where He came from
 - oHe is the heaven-sent Son of Man (1:51; Dan 7:13-14)
 - The not *just* the <u>Jewish</u> <u>Messiah</u>
 - The <u>King</u> of the *whole earth*
 - The giver of the Spirit of God

So What?

- We need a new birth through the Holy Spirit to be part of God's eternal kingdom oJesus alone offers that to us
- Have we been born again from above?
