What is the Church?

- The Church is a <u>community</u> bound together by our shared <u>beliefs</u> about who <u>Jesus</u> is 0 And, by extension, who we are
 - We are people who should acknowledge our <u>failings</u> and <u>brokenness</u> so that we can find <u>healing</u> in Jesus
- The Church is a place where <u>broken</u> people can find <u>healing</u> oIt is a <u>hospital</u> for <u>sinners</u> oNot a <u>museum</u> for <u>saints</u>
- It is NOT supposed to be a place where we hide from each other
 - oWe should be able to be <u>authentic</u> with one another
 - oNot because we are perfect
 - oBut because we know the love, mercy, and grace of God
 - oAnd we show those things to one another (John 13:34-35; 1 Pet. 4:8)

How Are We Doing?

- Are we the kind of Church that hides from one another?
- •Do we come on Sunday morning pretending everything is ok when it is not? •If so, why do we do that?
 - Do we fear judgement? (1 John 4:16-21)
- Do we welcome the wounded?
 - oIf someone were to walk through our doors on a Sunday morning and not know how to hide their sins and struggles, would they feel wanted and welcomed?
 - oWould we even invite them?

The Good News

- We as the Church have the words of Life because we have Jesus (John 6:68)
- The heart of the Gospel is that God meets us where we are and loves us fiercely o And then calls those who have experienced His love, mercy, and forgiveness to be <u>ambassadors</u> of Jesus to the world
 - oBy doing the same things Jesus did for us; meeting others where they are at and loving them fiercely (2 Cor. 5:16-20)

So What?

- Are we a community that lives out the Gospel to one another? • Showing God's grace, mercy, and love
- Are we proclaiming the Gospel to the broken around us? • Meeting them where they are at and loving them fiercely with Christ' love
