Armor Up: The Breastplate of Righteousness

(Ephesians 6:14b & Various Texts)

The Breastplate

• Breastplate (thorax): A piece of armor covering the chest to protect it against blows & arrows

Righteousness

- Dikaiosune: Righteousness & Justice
- <u>Positional</u> righteousness: <u>Right standing</u> before God o<u>Justification</u> which comes as a result of Christ's <u>death</u> (Rom. 3:21-26)
- Ethical righteousness: Acting rightly towards others (Job 29:14; Mic. 6:8)

Righteousness as Armor

- <u>Positional</u> righteousness acts as armor because we are relying on the work of <u>Jesus</u> oIt is putting on the righteousness of <u>Christ</u> to protect us (Isa. 59:17; 61:10)
- <u>Ethical</u> righteousness acts as armor because it is us living out the <u>transformation</u> that our new standing in Christ brings us (Eph. 4:24; 5:9)
- Like every other piece of armor, it is our <u>character</u> being made more like God (Eph. 5:1-5) oWhich is directly reflected in:
 - Our inner life
 - Our external actions
- When we live out this transformation:
- oWe do not let the <u>Devil</u> have an opportunity to attack us (Eph. 4:27)
- o Nor do we allow others an opening (1 Pet. 3:13-14)

When the War is Won

• When the battles are all won, we will still be <u>garbed</u> in righteousness oNot as <u>armor</u>, but as a <u>wedding dress</u> (Rev. 19:8)

So What?

- Are we guarded by our relationship with Jesus?
- Are we living out the transformation He is working in us?
