### **Biblical Compassion**

- In Scripture, compassion is NOT about feeling bad for someone or pitying them
  - o Even though, there is a place for that in the life of Christians
- Rather, Biblical Compassion is an expression of <u>love</u> focused in <u>understanding</u>
  - o Real love involves a deep, intimate knowledge of the beloved
- <u>Jesus' ministry</u> was marked by compassion (Matt. 9:36; see also Matt. 14:14; 15:32; Mark 6:34; 8:2; 9:22; Luke 7:13; 10:33)
  - o Because this reflects the heart of His Father (Luke 15:20)

### **People of Compassion**

- We are called to be <u>compassionate/loving</u> with others based upon the love that God has shown us (1 John 4:19-21)
- Jesus said that the world would know that we belong to Him by how we love (John 13:35)
  - o In fact, the most <u>repeated</u> command is Scripture is our call to love one another (John 13:34; see also John 15:12, 17; Rom. 12:10; 13:8; Eph. 4:2; 1 Thess. 3:12; 4:9; 1 Peter 1:22; 4:8; 1 John 3:11, 23 4:7, 11-12; 2 John 1:5)

#### Compassion with Skin on

- Scripture also gives us ideas of how to show this compassion through the 'one another's & 'each other's of the NT
  - o These are all expressions of God's love at work in us

## God is Love

- It is important for us to be defined by our love for God and one another
- And it is equally important to let God define what love is
  - Not culture
  - Not <u>emotions</u>
  - o GOD! (1 John 4:7-12)

#### So What?

- If we know God through Christ, we know what love looks like
- Are we letting God's compassionate love for us define how we treat others?

o So they can see God through us!
