What is Faithfulness?

- Pistis: 3 main meanings
 - o <u>Faith</u>: One's acceptance of the Gospel message and the committal of oneself to Christ as Savior and Lord
 - oThe Faith: The basic content of the Christian message
 - *<u>Faithfulness</u>, <u>fidelity</u>: the quality of being <u>true</u>, <u>trustworthy</u>, and <u>reliable</u> in all one's dealings with others

Our God is Faithful

- God's faithfulness is a cornerstone for our faith in Him (1 Cor 1:9)
- When He says He will do something, we can trust Him to follow through (Isa 25:1)
- Jesus exemplifies faithfulness in His ministry to and for us (Heb 2:17)
- God's faithfulness is our foundation to stand up to <u>temptation</u> (1 Cor 10:13)

Known for Our Faithfulness

- God's faithfulness is our foundation to be <u>faithful</u>
 It is the Spirit's work in us that helps us to be people who can be trusted
- Faithfulness is one of the highest <u>compliments</u> that God gives those who serve Him (Matt. 25:21)
 - oGod tests our faithfulness in order to entrust us with greater responsibilities
- When we have failed in our trustworthiness, we often feel compelled to add weight to our commitments (Jas 5:12)
 - OThis shows a lack of character and can leads to sin

Our Unfailing God

• The good news is that even when we <u>fail</u> to be faithful, God's faithfulness never <u>fails</u> (2 Tim 2:13)
