# The 7 Words of Christ on the Cross: Humanity

John 19:28

## "Knowing all was now completed"

- Jesus' work on the cross was coming to an end
  He had <u>suffered</u> for the sins of humanity and would soon <u>die</u> for them
- He was there to fulfill God's plan as revealed in Scripture

## "I am thirsty."

- $\Delta\iota\psi\tilde{\omega}$  (dipso): to suffer <u>thirst</u>; figuratively, those who are said to thirst who painfully feel their want of, and eagerly long for, those things by which the soul is refreshed, supported, strengthened
- Jesus was feeling His <u>humanity</u>

#### **Humanity**

- When Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit in Mary; God took on our humanity
- Jesus experienced what it meant to be <a href="https://example.com/human">human</a> in every way; but without <a href="mining">sinning</a> (Heb. 4:14-15)
- He lived a human life
- He was tempted as a human
- He suffered as a human
- And He died a human death
- Whatever we are going through, He has been there!
   And can <u>sympathize</u> with us!

#### So What?

- Because Jesus took on humanity, He knows how to help us in our struggles
- Are we asking for His help now?
