Armor Up: The Shield of Faith

(Ephesians 6:16 & Various Texts)

The Shield

- The shield referred to is the large shield carried by Roman soldiers, which covered the <u>whole person</u>
 - Often made of a metal frame with leather overlay
- It was ideal for protecting against <u>arrows</u>
 - OSome of which would be dipped in pitch and set aflame before being fired
 - OHowever, the shield could be soaked in <u>water</u> before a battle and would thus <u>extinguish</u> the <u>flaming</u> arrows when they hit it

Faith

- Faith is about trusting in God's own <u>faithfulness</u> (Pro. 30:5)
 - OHis trustworthiness
 - OHis ability to keep His promises
 - OHis power to overcome every enemy
- As God equips us with faith, it leads to a change in our <u>character</u> oMaking us more <u>faithful</u>, both to <u>God</u> & to <u>others</u>

Faith as a Shield

- To take the shield of faith is to apply the <u>promises</u> of God on our behalf with <u>confidence</u> that He will protect us in the midst of the battle (1 Pet. 5:8-9; Eph. 3:12)
 - oFirm faith= Belief with a flint-like resolution
- Like the shield itself, there is <u>preparation</u> required for faith to protect us from the 'flaming arrows' of the evil one
 - oWe must know God & His promises to trust Him during the battle

Group Formation

- God tells us that our brothers & sisters in Christ also face daily battle (1 Pet. 5:9)
- But there is an amazing thing about the Roman shield
 - oIt allowed battalions to use a <u>tortoise shell</u> formation which would protect the whole squad far better than a single soldier would be
- That is what we are supposed to do with one another (Ecc. 4:9-12)
 - oTo come along side & encourage
 - oTo remind & strengthen
 - oTo pick each other up when we fall
- In fact, one of the devil's favorite tactics is divide & conquer

So What?

- Are we putting our faith in our faithful God?
 OLetting Him protect us from attack
- Are we going into battle together?
