#### What is Kindness?

- Agathōsynē:
  <u>Benevolence</u>: Doing good to/for others
  - $\circ$  <u>Generosity</u>: Going the extra mile

## The Goodness of God

- God is the definer of what is <u>good</u>
  So whatever God does is, by definition, <u>good</u> (Mark 10:18)
- He constantly acts in the <u>benefit</u> of others (Ps. 103:2; 116:12)
- He is known for His generosity (Phil. 4:19)
  Even towards those who do not <u>acknowledge</u> Him (Matt. 5:44-45)

### For Goodness Sake

- We are called to reflect God's <u>benevolence</u> and <u>generosity</u> • Showing that God has <u>changed</u> us (Eph 5:8-10)
- Giving out the <u>abundance</u> which He has given to us (2 Cor. 9:10-11)

### A Heart Check

- The Holy Spirit produces goodness in us for the <u>benefit</u> of <u>others</u>
  - Which means giving to something or doing something that is <u>NOT</u> primary about benefiting us (Phil. 2:3-4)

### So What?

- Are we letting the Holy Spirit produce goodness in us?
- Do we look out for the interests of others?
- Are we known for our generosity?
