Putting Christ First: Thanksgiving & Prayer

Colossians 1:2b-12

Paul Gives Thanks (v. 2b-8)

- Paul starts with a standard greeting (v. 2b)
 - Grace: <u>Greek</u> greetingPeace: Hebrew greeting
- Paul thanks God for the Church's:
 - o Faith in Jesus (v. 4): Faith that has Jesus Christ as its ultimate reference point
 - oLove for God's people (v. 4, 8)
 - Based in the <u>hope</u> we have in God's work in <u>eternity</u> (v. 4)
 - And the Spirit at work in us now (v. 8)
- This message of u is presented in the Gospel
 - oThe truth about <u>Jesus</u>
 - Which was brought to the Colossians by <u>Epaphras</u>

Paul's Prayer (v. 9-12)

- He prays for the Church to have knowledge of God's will
 - So that we may live in a way that <u>pleases</u> God
 - Doing good
 - Growing to know* Him better
 - About a <u>relationship</u>
 - Growing to rely on His <u>strength</u> more
 - So that we may endure <u>hardships</u> with <u>patience</u>
 - Being <u>thankful</u>
 - Because of our understanding of what God has done and is doing for us through Christ
 - OWe are now heirs with Christ
 - OPart of God's family!

So What?

- Is our life defined by the truth of the Gospel?
- Are we living in a way that pleases God?
 - ONot through our strength
 - OBut through a growing relationship with Jesus
