What is Patience?

- Makrothumia: Long-suffering
 - oTo endure hardship
 - For a long period of time
 - That is very intense in its magnitude
 - <u>Bo</u>th

A God of Patience

- God is repeatedly described as <u>patient</u> (2 Pet. 3:9, 15a)
 - o Enduring our <u>sinful</u> <u>rebellion</u> to allow us opportunity to <u>repent</u> and turn to Him (see also Rom. 2:4; 9:22)
- God <u>restrains</u> His hand of <u>judgment</u> to work something greater
 - OIndividually: Like with Paul (1 Tim. 1:16)
 - o Corporately: Like Israel & the Amorites (Gen. 15:16)
 - o Temporally: Wanting as many people to turn to Him before Christ returns

Full of Patience

- For us, patience is the product of the Spirit working in our lives
- It is the outpouring of God's <u>love</u> through us (1 Cor. 13:4a; Eph. 4:2)
- And something we must <u>choose</u> (1 Thess. 5:14; Col. 3:12)
 - OLike <u>love</u>, joy, and <u>peace</u>
- It is often tied to <u>waiting</u> for God to <u>move</u> (Ps. 40:1)
 - Especially concerning <u>Christ's return</u> (Jas 5:7-8)
- And Him providing strength (Isa. 40:31)

So What?

- Are we letting the Spirit produce patience in us?
 - Learning to wait on God
 - oLearning to rest in Him
