Lies We Believe: God wants me to be happy?

Various Texts

The Claim: "God wants me to be happy."

Underlying premise: The most important thing in live is my happiness
 Can be used to try to justify <u>sinful</u> behavior

Scripture's Truth

- Happiness is a <u>fleeting emotion</u>
 It is based in our circumstances
- God's desire is for us to be:
 - OBlessed: Having His hand upon us
 - This happens as a result of our <u>obedience</u> to Him (Deut. 28:2; see also Deut. 11:27; Gen. 22:18; John 13:15-17)
 - o <u>Joyful</u>: A settled <u>assurance</u> that comes from knowing God is in control, and the determined <u>choice</u> to <u>praise</u> God in every situation
 - Unconditional

Trials that Bring Joy (James 1:2-4,12)

- Sometimes God brings <u>trials</u> into our lives
 - Their purpose is NOT to make us happy
 - Their purpose is to help us grow
- God's ultimate purpose is to make us more like <u>Jesus</u> (Rom 8:28-29)
- Jesus endured hardship because it brought joy (Heb. 12:1-2)
 - OWe are called to do the same

So What?

- God wants us to be blessed and joyful; and ultimately to be like Jesus!
- Are we focused on being obedient and growing in Christ-likeness?

Meditation Verse: Hebrews 12:1-2
