# Jesus, Our King

Matthew 2:1-6; Micah 5:2-5a

#### The Coming King

- Micah was a contemporary of <u>Isaiah</u> (700 BC)
   Foretold the coming of a king from Bethlehem
  - Whose beginnings were from <u>ancient</u> times
  - Not someone <u>new</u>
- Israel's 'abandonment' would end with the birth of a child
- He would have "brothers" who would join Him
- He would be a <u>shepherd</u>

oClothed in God's majesty

Bringing security

He would be their <u>peace</u>

## The King HAS Come

This king is <u>Jesus</u>!
He was born in <u>Bethlehem</u>
He is <u>eternal</u>
He <u>shepherds</u> His people
Through the Cross, He gives us <u>peace</u> with God

## The King IS Come

- He is here with us now through the Spirit
- He is still coming into people's hearts as we put our <u>trust</u> in Him • He is building the '<u>Kingdom/Kingship</u>' of God
- Through the Cross, He makes us His brothers and sisters

## The King WILL Come

• When Christ <u>returns</u>, then all the earth will <u>bow</u> before the King! (Micah 5:4)
