# Armor Up: The Sword of the Spirit

(Ephesians 6:17b & Various Texts)

### The Sword

- The <u>short-handled</u> sword of the Roman infantry oNormally about <u>2'</u> long in total
- Used for both offense & defense

### The Sword of the Spirit

- The sword is not the Spirit Himself, but rather, the <u>Word</u> of <u>God</u> oThe <u>Word</u> of God = God's <u>truth</u> & <u>promises</u> as found in the <u>Scriptures</u> (Pro. 30:5)
- It is the Sword of the *Spirit* becomes <u>living</u> & <u>active</u> through the power of the Holy Spirit (Heb. 4:12)

#### The Word as a Sword

- This is not a reference to the <u>Bible</u> as a <u>book</u> oA printed book has no intrinsic power
- Instead, Paul uses the term *rhema*, which means a spoken word
  - oThus, God's word acts as armor when it is declared
    - When we are in battle and <u>claim</u> His <u>promises</u> for us and for others
- This can only happen when we have know God's word intimately (Ps. 119:11) oWe need to be able to pull out that sword at a moment's notice
- The Sword is the only <u>offense</u> aspect to the armor of God
  - oIt is not that the devil cannot stand hearing God's word
  - oBut rather, as we faithfully proclaim the Gospel, people in Satan's sway might hear the liberating and life-giving message and be freed from his grasp

#### The Word as Armor

The Sword has <u>defensive</u> properties as well
OJesus uses Scripture to <u>rebuff</u> the devil when he was being <u>tempted</u> (Matt. 4:3-10)

# Weapons Used Wisely

- Like a real sword, God's word can be used with <u>malicious</u> intent oNotice that Satan used Scripture against Jesus too (Matt. 4:6)
- We must be mindful of how we use Scripture
  - oWe must understand & use it with its correct context & meaning
  - OScripture should never be used to wound or threaten other people!
    - Our enemy is the devil, not each other

#### So What?

- God's Word, made alive by the Holy Spirit, is our weapon against the devil oAre we equipping ourselves with it?
  - OAre we defending ourselves and others with it?
