Armor Up: The Belt of Truth

(Ephesians 6:14a & Various Texts)

A Belt as Armor

- Belts had several purposes in the ancient world
 - oCould refer to the leather apron used by soldiers to protect their legs
 - oCould be used to hold a sword and other gear
 - The most common use was to fasten clothing securely around one's waist
 - Preparation for vigorous activity (Luke 12:35, 37; 17:8)
 - In this case, readiness for <u>battle</u> (compare 1 Pet. 1:13a, NKJV & ESV)

Truth with a 'T'

- Just like the <u>strength</u> we need to wield God's armor must be from God Himself o'The Truth that protects us must be centered in <u>Jesus</u>
- <u>Jesus</u> is the source of Truth (John 14:6; 1:14, 17)
- We need to know Jesus to determine what is <u>truth</u> & <u>falsehood</u> (1 John 4:1-3a)

Truth as a Belt

- Truth acts as a belt because when we let it <u>surround</u> us: oIt protects us from the <u>lies</u> & <u>schemes</u> of the devil (John 8:44b; Eph 6:11) oIt <u>prepares</u> us for the battle ahead
 - Every piece of God's armor is a divine character trait that He wants to instill in us
 - God is trustworthy & has unflinching integrity
 - We are called to the same integrity (Prov. 2:7; Compare Isa. 6:5)
 - Integrity allows us to be in the thick of battle without faltering
