# He Leads Me (Ps. 23:2-3)

#### "He makes me lie down"

• The harsh climate and arid landscape of Israel meant that shepherds had to move their sheep to find <u>provisions</u> in a seasonally aware way

oThe shepherd had to know where <u>green grass</u> for food could be found at different times oHe needed to know where and when the <u>wadis</u> would be filled

- David states the Shepherd <u>makes</u> the sheep lie down •Once food was found, the shepherd at times needed to force them to stay
  - They would be prone to wander

#### "He restores my soul"

• When we follow the LORD, He provides what we need o<u>Food</u> & <u>water</u>

 $o\underline{\text{Rest}} =$  "waters of rest"

- <u>Rest/Sabbath</u> is a declaration of our trust in the LORD's provision
- This kind of rest leads to our restoration

### "He leads me"

- "Paths of righteousness" • God's leading results in us living out what is <u>right/correct</u>
  - Literally, walking the right path
- "For His name's sake" • Our right living brings <u>glory</u> to God • It is showing the world that He is <u>worth</u> following
