# The Gospel of John: The Resurrection & Life

John 11:1-44

#### Lazarus (v. 1-16)

- While Jesus is ministering near the Jordan, He receives word that His friend Lazarus is <u>sick</u> oThough his sisters are mentioned throughout each Gospel, only John mentions Lazarus by name (Mt 26:6-13; Mk14:3-9; Lk 10:38-42)
- Jesus doesn't immediately leave but waits 2 days • He assures the disciples that the sickness will not *end* in <u>death</u>
- The disciples warn Him of the <u>danger</u> of returning to the region oBecause Bethany is less than 2 miles from Jerusalem oHe replies that it's time to be <u>light</u> in <u>darkness</u>
- Jesus tells them that Lazarus has <u>died</u> and that He is going to use his <u>death</u> to reveal who He is

#### Martha (v. 17-27)

- When Jesus arrives, Lazarus has been dead <u>4</u> days

  o Jesus <u>waited</u> to come to ensure there was no question whether Lazarus was truly dead
- Lazarus' sister Martha insists that Jesus could have <u>healed</u> her brother's sickness oHe assures her that Lazarus will live again
  - She thinks He means the <u>resurrection</u> of all on the <u>Last Day</u>
  - OHe clarifies that He is the Resurrection & the Life
    - Jesus is the one who can give <u>new life</u>
- Martha declares her faith in Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God (v. 24; cf. 20:31)

### Mary (v. 28-37)

- Lazarus' other sister, Mary, also declares Jesus' ability to have prevented his death
- When He sees Mary & others weeping in <u>despair</u>, His response is <u>frustration</u> oThey were mourning like those who have no <u>hope</u>, like <u>resurrection</u> was a reality (1 Thes 4:13)

## The Final Sign (v. 38-44)

- Jesus commands that the stone be removed from the tomb despite the protests over the smell
- He prays <u>aloud</u> so that the crowd can hear
- He calls out for Lazarus to come out of the tomb
- Lazarus comes out <u>alive!</u>
   The linen used for embalming still wrapped around him
- In this final sign, Jesus shows He is the source of resurrection life (Jn 5:28-29)

#### So What?

- Jesus alone offers new life
   OHave we trusted Him for it?
- He is the God of new beginnings!
