We Believe in Jesus' Work (Various Texts)

EFCA Statement of Faith, Article 5

We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed His blood on the cross as the perfect, all-sufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.

Our Representative & Substitute

- Because Jesus is fully <u>human</u>, He is our perfect <u>representative</u>

 Just as in <u>Adam</u> all humans found their original identity, in Jesus, the second <u>Adam</u>, we can find our new identity (1 Cor 15:45, 47; Gen. 2:15-17)
- This means that Jesus can serve as our perfect <u>substitute</u> (Rom 5:18-19; Mark 1:45; Heb 2:16-17; 1 Pet 3:18)

Our Sacrifice

- God tells us that <u>blood</u> must be shed for <u>sin</u> (Lev. 17:11)
- Jesus does this for us through His <u>blood</u> on the Cross (Mat 26:28; Heb. 9:14, 22; 10:19; 1 Pet. 1:18-19; Rev. 12:10-11)
 - o And His sacrifice for us was perfect & all-sufficient (Heb 9:24-28)

Our Salvation

- Jesus' death brought <u>atonement</u> • Paid the <u>penalty</u> of our sins (1 Jn. 2:2; Rom. 3:25; Heb. 2:17; 1 Jn. 4:10)
- And His resurrection assured our victory over <u>death</u> (Col 2:13-15; 1 Cor. 15:54-55; Col. 1:13; Heb. 2:14-15)
- Thus, it is only Jesus' work, not ours, that <u>saves</u> us from sin, death, and ourselves (Act 4:12; Rom. 4:25; 6:4, 11, 14; 1 Cor. 6:14; 15:20; 2 Cor. 4:14; Eph. 1:19-20; 2:5-6; 1 Pet. 1:3)

So What?

- It is only through the work of Jesus that we can have real life both now and into eternity
- Do we know Jesus and have this life?
