# Immanuel: The Gift of the King of Love

Luke 2:1-14

### The Setting (v. 1-7)

- Mary & Joseph have traveled from Nazareth to Bethlehem
  - oBecause of <u>Caesar's</u> tax decree (v. 1)
  - OBecause both were descendants of David
- While they are there, Mary gives birth to <u>Jesus</u>

  oHe is laid in a <u>manger</u> because there isn't enough room for the family in the upstairs guest room

#### The Shepherds (v. 8-9)

- During that time, shepherds were social outcasts
- But these are the same hills that <u>David</u> raised sheep on as a boy
   The <u>king</u> who was a shepherd

### The Message (v. 10-11)

- "Good News": Evangelion/Gospel
- "Of great joy": Which will change one's eternal outlook
- "For all people": Starting with the lowly shepherds, but will affect the whole world (Luke 2:17)
- "In the town of David": fulfilling God's promise (Micah 5:2, c. 735 BC)
- "A Savior has been born": This child will save God's people
- "He is the Messiah, the Lord"
  - oHe is both Christ/Messiah: God's anointed king from the line of David
  - oAnd Lord: God incarnate
  - oThe fulfillment of all the promises of Immanuel (Isa 7-11)

# The King of Love (v. 12)

- Yet, He will be found in a feeding trough and wrapped in rags (v. 12)
- ONot the expected welcome for a king, much less God incarnate
- OBut <u>love</u> meets us where we are
  - Jesus came in poverty and humility because we are poor and humble

# The Praise (v. 13-14)

- More angels appear and sing God's praises (v. 13)
- And proclaim that this child has brought God's peace to earth (v. 14)
- And the shepherds spread the word of His birth (v. 17)

#### So What?

- Jesus is God's gift of love
  - OHe is the King of the Universe who loved us enough to meet us in our poor and humble humanity
  - OHe came to show us His great love for us
- He is Immanuel, God with us
