Centered in Christ: Putting on the New

Colossian 3:12-17

Putting on New Clothes (v. 12-14)

- Because we are new in Christ
 - <u>Chosen</u> and <u>loved</u> by God
 - ○<u>Set apart</u> for God
- We should seek to emulate Jesus with:
 - OCOMPASSION (lit. 'guts of pity'): To be moved by what moves Him
 - o<u>Kindness</u>/<u>Generosity</u>: To look to the <u>needs</u> of others
 - o<u>Humility/Modesty</u>: To think of ourselves <u>rightly</u>
 - <u>Meekness</u>: To not being overly impressed by a sense of one's <u>self-importance</u>
 - <u>Patience</u>: being <u>self-controlled</u> in the face of provocation
 - ◦<u>Tolerance</u>: Putting up with the <u>struggles</u> of others
 - OFOR EVEN STATE OF A STATE OF
- All of these are just how <u>Jesus</u> treats us
 And all of which can be summed up in one command: <u>Love</u> each other! (John 13:34-35)

Taking Up New Residents (v. 15-16)

- We are called to let Christ's peace rule in us
 - \circ This is a call to let the Jesus take <u>control</u> of our lives
 - "Heart": Place of <u>will</u>, <u>decision</u>
 - "Rule": <u>Umpire</u>, <u>arbiter</u>
 - Peace should always take <u>precedence</u> in the life of a Christian, because of the peace we have with <u>God</u> through <u>Christ</u>
 - Which should lead to gratitude
- We are to let Christ's word dwell in us
 - ○The <u>truth</u> of the Gospel should <u>transform</u> us
 - ○And we should <u>encourage</u> each other deeper and deeper into that truth through:
 - Teaching: Show what is right
 - Admonishing: Correcting what is wrong
 - Praising God together

Living Out a New Mission (v. 17)

- With our new *identity* in place
 - And our thinking & words being <u>conformed</u> to Christ
- We are called to let everything we <u>do</u> and <u>say</u> reflect <u>Jesus</u> to the world
- This is <u>result</u> of putting Christ first in our lives

So What?

- Are we letting Jesus transform our lives?
 - $\circ~$ So we are loving each other the way He loves us
 - $\circ~$ And so we are reflecting Him to the world
