Ephesians: Walking in Wisdom?

(Ephesians 5:8-14)

Not of this World (v. 8-10)

- Previous, Paul called us to not be partnered with those of this world (v. 7)
- Here, we see the reason why: Because we are partnered with <u>Christ</u> OAnd therefore, children of <u>light</u>
 - ONot to return to darkness
- Such a shift in identity should <u>produce</u> different behavior in us:
 - oGoodness: Interest in the welfare of others
 - o Righteousness: God-honoring behavior
 - oTruth: Reflecting the truth of Jesus to others

Living as Light (v. 11-14)

- We are called to leave behind our old ways of <u>living</u> and <u>thinking</u> (v. 11)
- As light, we are called to expose those deeds as <u>shameful</u>
 - OLight makes things that were hidden visible
 - oFor the purpose of healing
 - So that <u>Jesus</u> can heal others as He has healed us (v. 14)
