Ephesians: The Power of God

Ephesians 1:15-23

Paul's Gratitude (v. 15-16)

- He is grateful for the <u>Ephesians</u>
 OHe knows of their <u>reputation</u>
- They are known for their:
 - oFaith in Jesus
 - oLove for God's people

Paul's Prayer (v. 17-19a)

- Paul's request is based in God being a Giver
- He has given us <u>Jesus</u>, His <u>Son</u>
 And through Him, <u>salvation</u>, <u>adoption</u>, and <u>forgiveness</u>
- He has given us His Spirit
- And intimate knowledge through the Spirit
 - oWisdom: Knowing God's will
 - ORevelation: Knowing God
 - oEnlightenment
 - *Knowing* the <u>hope</u> that we have in Him
 - *Knowing* the <u>riches</u> which we will receive
 - Knowing the power at work in us

The Power of God (v. 19b-23)

- 9 terms are used for "power" in v. 19-21
- The power of God is effective to not only rule mightily
 - But also, to raise Christ from the dead
- This power puts Jesus above every <u>ruler</u>, <u>authority</u>, <u>power</u>, <u>dominion</u>, & <u>title</u> on earth & in heaven
- It is this power that guides the Church
- It is this power that is <u>alive</u> in <u>us</u> when we are *in Christ* Available through the <u>Spirit</u> of God
