The Story So Far

- Jesus had spent the last 3 years of His earthly life:

 Proclaiming that <u>God's kingdom</u> was becoming reality (Luke 17:20-21)
 Promising a way for people to have a <u>restored relationship</u> with God (John 14:6, 23)
 Demonstrating His identity through <u>miracles</u> and <u>signs</u> (John 14:10-11)
 - Prophesying that He would be <u>killed</u> but would come back to <u>life</u> after 3 days (Mark 8:31; see also Matt. 12:40; 26:61; Mark 9:31; 10:34 ; 14:58; John 2:19)
- He was removed from the cross, and quickly placed in a nearby tomb by Joseph of Arimathea & Nicodemus
 - Because the Sabbath was approaching, a day on which Jews would not have touched a dead body

The End of the Story?

- And if Jesus was anyone else, that would have been the end of his story
- A life filled with empty promises, empty suffering, and empty hope
- And hardly anyone today would have even heard of him
 He would be, at best, a footnote in some obscure history book like the hundreds of other would-be Messiahs of his day
- But the only thing empty about Jesus is His tomb!

The Empty Tomb

- Because His Tomb is empty:
 - ○His <u>promises</u> are full
 - His suffering has meaning
 - ○And we have <u>HOPE</u>!
- Everything that Jesus said is true!
 He has made a way for us to have a <u>right relationship</u> with God through faith in Him
 He is who <u>He said He is</u>
 - And we are who <u>He says we are</u> (John 1:12)
 - o Death could not defeat Him but rather He defeated death
 - And through Him, we have new <u>life</u> (John 5:24)
 - The Kingdom of God is at work through the Holy Spirit in us who believe (Rom. 14:17; 8:11)

- Have you come to know Jesus?
- Are you trusting everything He said?
