ACTS: Berea

Acts 17:10-15

A Warm Welcome (v. 10-12)

- After the arrest and release of Jason and others, the newly formed Christian community sends Paul & co. out of town by <u>night</u>
- They are sent to the city of <u>Berea</u>, about 50 miles inland to the west oIt would have been about a 3-days journey
- Berea, which is the modern-day city of Veria, Greece, lays on the eastern slopes of Mt. Vermion in the <u>Olympian</u> Mountain range
 - OAbout 60 miles north of Mt. Olympus
 - OIt was the capital of one of the four divisions of Macedonia
- Again, Paul visits the synagogue to preach first to the Jews and God-fearing Gentiles
- However, unlike in Thessalonica, the Jews here welcome him oThey are called <u>noble</u>: a quality connected with <u>openness</u>, <u>tolerance</u>, & <u>generosity</u>
- They are also eager to hear what Paul has to say
 - oThey meet daily, not weekly
 - They search the Scriptures to verify the claims being made
- Because of this commitment to the truth, many of them <u>believed</u> in Jesus oBoth <u>Jews</u> and <u>Greeks</u>
- The Bereans wanted to make sure that who they are and what they believe were rooted in <u>God's Word</u>
 - OTo this day, it is what they are most known for
- We must be careful to do the same

Trouble Follows (v. 13-15)

- The Jews in Berea seemed to have no problem with Paul's preaching about Jesus oBut others from <u>Thessalonica</u> heard about Paul's success and started causing problems
- Again, the crowds are riled against the Apostles
 But this time, it is <u>Paul</u> alone who is singled out
- Paul leaves town, being escorted to the <u>coast</u>
 - OAnd eventually all the way to Athens
 - oWhether he traveled by boat or along the coastal road is unknown
- However, <u>Silas</u> & <u>Timothy</u> stay behind in Berea to continue to train up the newly formed Church o'They later meet up with Paul in Athens after he sends his escorts back for them (Acts 18:5)
