The Gospel of John: Greater & Lesser

John 3:22-36

Baptizers (v. 22-25)

- Jesus & His disciples are ministering in the Judean wilderness near a site where <u>John</u> is still <u>baptizing</u> people
 - oJohn's baptism is an act of repentance & preparation to meet the Messiah
- Jesus's *disciples* are also <u>baptizing</u> people
 Jesus never baptized anyone in <u>water</u> (see John 4:2)
 Their baptism ministry is a continuation of John's
 It is not the baptism by the <u>Spirit</u> & <u>fire</u> that Jesus offers later (Acts 1:5) and that we receive when we accept Christ
- John's disciples and another Jew are arguing about <u>ceremonial washing</u>, a Jewish custom (2:6) distinct from John's baptism
 - The argument was probably over a misunderstanding about the distinctions between <u>ritual</u> <u>purity</u> (ceremonial washing) & <u>repentance</u> (John's baptism)

Knowing Your Role (v. 26-30)

- John's disciples are concerned that Jesus' ministry is outpacing his
- John's response shows that he understands his <u>role</u> oHe's not the <u>groom</u> at this wedding; he's the <u>best man</u> oThe focus of his mission is not <u>himself</u>; it is <u>Jesus</u>
- John understands that he needs to "get out of the way" until everything is about Jesus oIf people are going to Jesus, then he is doing his job oThis is true for us too!

The Gospel Truth (v. 31-36)

- John then summarizes the ministry of Jesus
- Jesus, the heaven-sent Son of God, can uniquely show us the <u>truth</u> oUltimately, all <u>truth</u> is centered in Him
- He gives those who trust Him <u>eternal life</u> *right now* with the giving of the <u>Spirit</u> o"*has* eternal life"
- But, if we <u>reject</u> the truth of Jesus, we are still under God's <u>wrath</u> • The <u>punishment</u> that our <u>sins</u> deserve (Rom 2:5-8)
- God desires to show us mercy, grace, and love through Jesus (2 Pet 3:9; Mt 18:14)

So What?

- Are we believing the truth about Jesus? • Or trying to live our own way?
- Are we making sure that Jesus takes center stage in our lives? • Or are we making everything about us?
