## We Believe: in God, part 2 (Various Texts)

## EFCA Statement of Faith, Article 1, pt. 2

We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit...

### Eternally Existing

God is <u>eternal</u>
<u>oTime</u> is a creation of God
OAnd just like the rest of His creation, God is not <u>bound</u> by it (Ps. 102:25-27)

## A Loving Unity

- <u>Love</u> is one of the defining characteristics of God because at His core God is <u>love</u> (1 John 4:8, 16)
- Within the Godhead there exists a <u>relationship</u> of a mutual <u>love</u> and <u>giving</u> to the others (John 3:35; 17:24; Luke 12:10)
- This love is so perfect that it results in a <u>unity</u> that makes the <u>3</u> persons of the Godhead <u>1</u>: <u>Trinity</u> o<u>Father</u> (Dt. 32:6; Mt. 6:6; Rom. 8:15; 1 Cor. 8:6)
  o<u>Son</u> (Matt.3:17; Jn. 1:14; 3:16; Gal. 4:4; Heb. 1:5)
  o<u>Holy Spirit</u> (Jn. 14:16, 17, 26; 15:26; 16:7-15; Rom. 8:9, 26; Gal. 4:6)

# 3 Who Are 1

- All 3 persons of the Trinity are equally God (Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19; 1 Peter 1:2)
- All persons of Trinity are active in all aspects of the work of God o In <u>Creation</u> (Gen 1:1-2; John 1:1-3)
  o In <u>Salvation</u> (Gal 4:6)
  o In <u>Prayer</u> (John 14:13; Rom. 8:26)
- This oneness is reflected in God's desire for <u>human</u> relationships as well • As we were <u>designed</u> (Gen 2:24) • Which can be <u>restored</u> through the work of Trinity in us (John 17:11)
