Acts 2:42-47

The Church's Devotion (v. 42)

- As the Church grew, they were devoted to 4 things:
- 1. The Apostle's teaching: <u>Scripturally</u> rooted, <u>Spirit-led</u> instruction
- 2. Fellowship: Spending time with one another for mutual encouragement and support
- 3. The Breaking of Bread: Three possible meanings
 - o Communion
 - Sharing meals together
 - o Both
- 4. Prayer: Seeking the Lord together

The Spirit's Power on Display (v. 43)

- The <u>Spirit's</u> work continued through the Apostles in the form of <u>signs</u> and <u>wonders</u>
 - Which resulted in a God-centered <u>awe/fear</u> from those who witnessed them

Devotion Lived Out (v. 44-47)

- As a result of the Spirit's <u>transformative</u> work in the lives of believers, they lived <u>differently</u> than the world around them
 - o They shared what they had
 - So that everyone's <u>needs</u> were met
 - They gathered together <u>daily</u>
 - Both <u>publicly</u> and in <u>homes</u>
 - They were <u>joyful</u>
 - Praising God
 - Which acted as a witness to the public
- As they did so, the result was a constant growth of the Church
 - Led by the <u>Lord's</u> movement in His people

Prescription vs. Description?

- The practices of the early Church were not just a one-time event
- These things have been the <u>universal</u> practices of the Church ever since
 - The heart of being the Church is found in these
 - o When we add to them, we often take away from what and whom we are called to be
- But when we focus on:
 - o Biblical, Spirit-led teaching
 - o Fellowship
 - Living life together
 - Prayer

Christ is glorifiedAnd He grows the Church
