Various Texts

The Claim: "I don't need the Church."

- \bullet The underlying premise: Our relationship with God does not require others $_{\odot}$ "It's just me and Jesus."
 - $\circ \ensuremath{\mathsf{Sometimes}}$ this thinking a rejection of organized religion
 - \circ But there is a real danger in this thinking

Scripture's Truth

- Scripture *does* talk about our need for a <u>personal relationship</u> with God through Jesus (Rom. 10:9)
- However, it also talks about our need for true Christian <u>community</u> to be who God calls us to be (Heb 10:24-25)
 - oI cannot be who Jesus calls me to be alone

The Church is...

- Who we are: Ekklesia= "Those who are called out" • Not what we <u>do</u>: We don't 'do church'
 - $\circ \text{Not}$ a <u>place</u> we gather: We don't 'go to church'
- The <u>Body</u> of <u>Christ</u>: The hands and feet of Jesus to <u>each other</u> and our <u>neighbors</u> (1 Cor 12:27)

• Everyone using their gifts for the common good (Rom 12:4-6a; 1 Cor 12:7)

The Purpose of the Church

- To show the world who Jesus is by <u>loving God</u>
 - <u>Worship</u>: Declaring to God His worth (Heb. 12:28)
 - Can be done alone, but often better with others
 - <u>Discipleship</u>: Growing in our <u>relationship</u> with Him (Rom 12:1)
 - An act of <u>love</u> toward God
- To show the world who Jesus is by <u>loving each other</u>
 - <u>Fellowship</u>: <u>Gathering</u> together in Jesus' name (1 John 1:7)
 - <u>Discipleship</u>: <u>Encouraging</u> one another to grow in our relationship with Jesus (Eph 4:15-16)
 - <u>Service</u>: Showing Christ's love in <u>practical</u> ways (Gal 5:13)
- To show the world who Jesus is by <u>loving</u> our <u>neighbors</u> (Gal 5:14) • Evangelism: Sharing Christ's love in word and deed (Matt 28:18-20)
 - <u>Evangelism</u>. Sharing entist's love in <u>word</u> and <u>acca</u> (Matt 28 • Service: Showing Christ's love in practical ways (Jas 2:16)

How We Are the Church

- Being the Church is not *primarily* about what we do on Sundays
 That *is* a time for <u>worship</u>, <u>discipleship</u>, <u>service</u>, and <u>fellowship</u>
 But it is not our *only* opportunity for those things
- We can gather for those purposes at other times and in other ways as well • And sometimes more <u>effectively</u>
- Right Now
 - Continue with weekly online worship services
 - o Have occasional in-person services
 - Outdoor Service June 21st
 - Intentional Small Groups that will focus on missional living
 - Reflecting Acts 2:42

So What?

- We need each other to be the people God desires us to be
- That is not *primarily* about Sunday mornings
- It is about gathering together and going out into the world to be the hands and feet of Jesus • Showing each other and the world the love of Jesus at work in us
