New Year's Reflection: Rebirth & Renewal

Titus 3:3-7

The Promise of a New Year

- A new year gives us hope of a new beginning
- We set out to make changes that often fail to follow through on OBecause we do not have the power to change some parts of who we are

The Old Self (v. 3)

- Paul describes what our lives look like when we try to live them our way oFoolish: Lived like there was no God (Ps 14:1)
 - ODisobedient: Lived in rebellion
 - oDeceived: Lived like our actions had no eternal consequences
 - o Enslaved to passions & pleasures: Let our appetites become our <u>masters</u>
 - oMalicious: Acting wickedly
 - o Envious: Wanting what others have, even if that means they lose it
 - OHating others and being hated by them
- Verse 3 starts with "That was then"
- Verse 4 begins with "This is now"
 - oWe no longer need to be characterized by this diabolical list
 - OChange can happen

The Catalyst of Change (v. 4-6)

- But when God our Savior shows up
 - OWith kindness: Goodness toward us
 - oWith <u>love</u> (philanthropia) = <u>love</u> for humanity
- He saves us from our sins and ourselves
 - ONot because of our actions
 - Rather, despite them
 - OBut because of His mercy
 - Showing compassion on us while in our wretchedness
- Through the washing of rebirth
 - OWashing: symbolizing baptism
 - To be lost in that which one is immersed
 - ORebirth: To be born again or anew
 - See John 3 (Jesus & Nicodemus)
- Renewal = a fresh \underline{start}
- Birth is a passive act for the child
 - OTraumatic, but passive
- The "labor" is done by the mother
 - oIn this case, the Holy Spirit
 - oWho is given when we trust in <u>Iesus</u> (v. 6)

The Effects of Rebirth (v. 7)

- If know Jesus, we have been <u>justified</u> (made right before God) oBy His <u>grace</u> (free gift)
 - His work, not ours
 - The only work He asks of us is to <u>believe</u> (John 6:29)
 - An utter dependence on Him
- Then, we get a new <u>identity</u>, a <u>child</u> of <u>God</u> • We are reborn to become <u>heirs</u> of His life
 - <u>Eternal</u> life

So What?

Do we need a new start?
God offers it to us through Jesus
He works it out in us through the Holy Spirit
