The Gospel of John: The Plot & the Anointing

John 11:45-12:11

The Plot (11:45-57)

- Jesus' final sign causes many to put their faith in Him
- The Sanhedrin (Jewish ruling council) debates what to do
 - They are concerned that Jesus will cause rebellion against Rome, which will result in their national demise
 - oCaiaphas, the High Priest, declares that they should kill Jesus
 - He does not realize that he is speaking <u>prophetically</u> that Jesus would <u>die</u> for the <u>Jews</u> and the rest of <u>humanity</u> (Jn 10:16)
- Jesus retreats to the town of Ephraim
- Everyone is looking for Him to return to Jerusalem for <u>Passover</u>
 OBut first, He returns to <u>Bethany</u>

The Anointing (12:1-8)

- Six days before <u>Passover</u>, Jesus returns to Bethany
- Jesus & the disciples attend a meal in Jesus' honor • <u>Lazarus</u> & his sisters are present
- Mary takes expensive <u>perfume</u> and pours it on Jesus' <u>feet</u> & wipes them with her <u>hair</u>
 OBoth the quantity & quality shows Mary's <u>devotion</u> to Jesus
 OHis feet are emphasized to show her <u>humility</u> & a possible <u>foreshadowing</u> of the events of ch.
 13
- <u>Judas Iscariot</u> protests that Mary's act is a waste of money o Suggesting that the perfume could have been sold and the money used for the <u>poor</u> o John informs us that Judas was a <u>thief</u> and wanted access to the money for himself
- Jesus rebukes him, stating that Mary has <u>anointed</u> Him for His <u>burial</u>
 The focus is on Jesus' imminent <u>sacrifice</u>
 From this moment on, every act of Jesus is leading to the <u>Cross</u>

Faith & Fallout (12:9-11)

- When news spread that He had returned to Bethany, people came to see <u>Iesus</u> & <u>Lazarus</u>
- This caused even more people to put their faith in Him
- It also made the Sanhedrin realize that they needed to kill <u>Lazarus</u> as well to stop the spread of <u>faith</u> in Jesus
 - OHis testimony was too much for them to fight

So What?

- Mary's humility was used to highlight Jesus' sacrifice, even though she did not know it
- What are ways that we show our devotion to God?
- How do our lives highlight Jesus to those around us?
