#### The Lord is Come!

Luke 2:8-14

### The Angelic Announcement (v. 8-10)

- The angel declares that his message is:
  - o <u>Good news</u> (Gospel)
  - O A cause of great joy
  - O A message for all people

# The Gospel Declared (v. II)

- A Savior is born
  - O Jesus comes to save us from our sins (Matt I:21)
- He is the <u>Christ/Messiah</u>
  - The promised <u>king</u> from the line of <u>David</u> who will reign over the whole <u>world</u> (Isa 9:6-7)
- He is the LORD!
  - O He is God Almighty come in the flesh (John I:I, I4)

# The Sheperd King (v. 12-14)

- But this divine king would not be found in the glory of a warm palace
  - O Rather, He is found in the <u>humbleness</u> of rags & a feeding trough
  - The Gospel is first delivered to humble <u>shepherds</u> because they would be able to recognize the <u>Good Shepherd</u> (John 10:14-15)
- The angel is joined by others who declare that <u>peace</u> has come to earth because of this child
  - O Not a lack of <u>human</u> turmoil, but peace with <u>God</u> (Rom 5:I)

#### So What?

- Do we know Jesus, the Shepherd King who gives us peace with God?
- Do we proclaim Him to the world, like the shepherds did (Lk 2:20)?
