Various Texts

Just like Jesus

- Jesus came to <u>serve</u> (Phil 2:7; Mark 10:45)
- We are called to mimic His behavior (Mark 10:42-44; 1 John 2:6)

A Heart of Service

- Paul referred to himself as a <u>slave</u> in Christ's service (Rom. 1:1; Phil. 1:1; Titus 1:1)
 But a <u>freed</u> slave who serves out of <u>gratitude</u> & <u>love</u> (Rom 6:18, 22)
- Jesus frees us to serve out of selflessness (Rom 7:6; 1 Cor 9:19; Gal 5:13)
- Service is one of our highest honors (Matt 25:23)

How Do We Serve?

- In the Church (1 Pet. 4:10-11)
- In our <u>homes</u> (Eph. 5:21)
 - o<u>Submit</u>: In non-military use, it was "a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden".
 - Wives (Eph. 5:22-24)
 - <u>Husbands</u> (Eph. 5:25-33)
 - <u>Children</u> (Eph. 6:1-3)
 - <u>Parents</u> (Eph. 6:4)
- In our <u>work</u> (Eph 6:5-8)
- In our communities (Col. 4:5-6; Gal. 6:10; Matt. 25:35-40)
