What is Kindness?

- Χρηστός (chrestos):
 - OUprightness in one's relations with others
 - oThe quality of being helpful or beneficial

The Kindness of God

- We are called to kindness because God is kind to us
- It is God's kindness that led to Christ's <u>redemptive</u> work (Tts 3:4-5; Eph 2:4-7)
- Our response to God's kindness should be <u>repentance</u> (Rom 2:4)
 - OMeaning, a change in our <u>behavior</u> (Rom 11:22)

A Testimony of Kindness

- Paul tells the church in Corinth that kindness was part of how he won them over to the message of the <u>Gospel</u> (2 Cor. 6:6)
- Kindness is one of the ways that we show that we are <u>God's people</u> (Col 3:12)
 And have experienced forgiveness (Eph. 4:32)
- Our behavior towards others is to be helpful and beneficial
 - OEven if is difficult for us
 - o Especially if they differ with us (1 Cor 4:13a)
 - ○Thus, kindness is an act of <u>love</u> (1Co 13:4a)

So What?

- Are we working with the Spirit to produce kindness in us?
- Are we known for our kindness towards others?
 - Even those with whom we differ
- Are we helpful and a benefit to others?
