### The Gospel (v. 14-36)

- Peter presents the crowd with who Jesus is, including:
  His <u>origin</u>
  His <u>power</u>
  His <u>role</u> as <u>Christ</u>
  His <u>crucifixion</u>
  His <u>resurrection</u>
  Calling them to see this truth based on <u>Scripture</u>
- ○Including their <u>role</u> in it all

### The Response (v. 37-41)

- Many wanted to know how to respond to the truth they had heard
   <u>Repent</u> & be <u>baptized</u>
   And they will be filled with the <u>Holy Spirit</u> too
- And <u>3000</u> of them were • And so it began!

### The Giving of the Spirit (v. 1-4)
